Dear Principal,

The 2022 Primary Schools Cross Country Championships will take place on Wednesday 28th September in Thurles Crokes Complex, Nenagh Rd., Thurles. Entries will be accepted by EMAIL ONLY to tipperaryschoolsathletics@gmail.com on the attached Entry form. Entries close on Friday September 23rd 2022

For the safety of all competitors, we are going to continue to divide our Primary Schools Cross Country Championship into **TWO** sessions. A race for special needs children will be held between the first and second session.

SCHOOLS WILL BE CONFINED TO THEIR OWN CATEGORY. If you are late for your race, your athletes will not be allowed score in any other race.

School Categories: **Mixed Schools Only:** **Extra Small**-55 pupils or less: **Small**-56-85 pupils: **Medium**-86-110 Pupils: **Large**-111 to 180 Pupils: **Major**-Over 180 Pupils. **Single Gender Schools:** Category will be decided by doubling the Roll Numbers.

Session 1 will start at 10.30am **SHARP** and will include **Extra Small, Small & Medium Schools.**

Special Needs Race

Session 2 will start at 11.40am approx. and will include **Major & Large Schools.**

All numbers must be collected by 10.15am for 1st Session and 11.15am for 2nd Session. Numbers allocated to each competitor must be strictly adhered to.

Any incorrect number used by a competitor will be declared null and void and will not be considered for the result, so please double check that each child has the correct number. In the past, giving out incorrect numbers has caused major delays in the processing of results.

We will use starting stalls to give everybody the same advantage. Please place **your better runners at the front** of your **team**. Results of every race will be available within twenty minutes of race finish and will be posted up at the Clubhouse entrance. **We ask all Schools to collect their medals on the day.** The results will also be posted on www.tipperaryathletics.com

Teams, Scoring System & Prizes

There is no limit on team size or on the number of pupils a school may enter.

For Small and X-Small Schools it is **THREE ATHLETES TO SCORE.**

In all other categories it is **FOUR TO SCORE.**

Medals will be presented to the First 10 Individuals in each Race and the scoring members of the first 3 teams.
